Boise, Idaho – Since 1977, Preservation Idaho has hosted the Orchids and Onions Awards, an event ceremony designed to celebrate individuals and organizations that have contributed positively to historic preservation, as well as to bring awareness to those projects that have shown insensitivity to Idaho's cultural history. To do this, we need your help! We want to hear from our community about what preservation projects *you* think are worthy of celebrating.

Orchids are granted to outstanding examples of preservation projects or practices in the following categories:

- Excellence in Historic Preservation
- Contribution to Historic Preservation
- Preservation-Sensitive New Construction
- Cultural Heritage Preservation
- Friend of Preservation
- Distinguished Preservationist
- Heritage Stewardship
- Scott Chandler Award for Excellence in Craftsmanship

Onions: Onions are awarded to projects that jeopardize Idaho's cultural resources.

Evaluation and selection: An independent review committee will be appointed to review nominations. The committee will be made up of preservationists, historians, and architects who will review and evaluate nominations for suitability in their category.

Awards ceremony: Award recipients will be honored at the 46th Annual Orchids and Onions Awards Ceremony in Boise, Idaho at TRICA on July 22, 2023.
